2011 Girls for the Cure Student Scholarship Call for Submissions

Background

Established in 1995, Girls for the Cure (GFC) is a student-run initiative that raises funds for women-related cancer treatment and services. Through a variety of fundraising and educational activities, students from six Montreal-area independent girls' schools (Miss Edgar's and Miss Cramp's, Queen of Angels Academy, Sacred Heart, The Study, Trafalgar School for Girls and Villa Maria) rally the support of their communities for this important event.

Scholarship

The GFC scholarship program was established to provide financial support to young women who demonstrate leadership, volunteerism, integrity and citizenship. The scholarship will be awarded to support studies, projects and/or initiatives at the secondary (Sec IV & Sec V) or post-secondary level (up to 3 years post-secondary graduation).

Funding

Funding will support:

- Projects in the area healthcare sciences;
- Humanitarian and volunteer initiatives in Canada, abroad or elsewhere;
- Projects or educational activities focused on women-related cancers;
- Registration fees and travel expenses related to seminars or workshops in the area of healthcare sciences or healthcare philanthropy.

Funding will not support:

- Participation in other charity sponsored initiatives (i.e. ...a-thons, direct donations).

Amount:

- Up to \$1,500 to be used within a period of one-year following receipt of the award.
